



What to expect after my Skin Lesion Excision Procedure?

Once your skin lesion has been removed through excision you will have to wait for around a week for the healing process to complete. The wound will heal like any other cut or graze. You may have a dressing on for a day or two after the procedure. This can be removed after 2 days.

After this time, it would be a good idea to keep the wound as clean as possible, bathe with cool boiled water, pat dry, use antiseptic sprays or creams if needed and if you are experiencing any discomfort to take everyday painkillers.

You may notice the following:

Bruising: It is common to experience bruising. This will resolve within 3-5 days.

Swelling and redness: This is normal and usually settles after two or three days.

Infection: Infection can occur, resulting in increased pain and the formation of pus. This may require topical antiseptic or antibiotic therapy.
